



MEMBERSHIP RULES OF ORDER

1. Any motion or amendment shall be in writing, signed by the maker, and presented to the Secretary before it is moved.
2. The maker of a motion shall be entitled to speak first in support of the motion.
3. Persons wishing to speak shall state their name before speaking.
4. No member may speak more than two (2) minutes at a time unless allowed to do so by a two-thirds vote of the members present without debate.
5. No member may address the assembly a second time on the same question until all members who desire to speak on the motion have spoken.
6. A member cannot speak for or against a motion and then make a Subsidiary, Privileged or Incidental motion.
7. These rules shall be adopted by a majority vote of the members present. Once adopted, these rules may be suspended or amended by a majority vote of members.
8. Identification of a voting member shall be by colored name badge. Green badges will identify PT members and yellow badges will identify PTA members. Chapter members with a white badge will not be eligible to vote or speak to a motion unless they exchange their white badge for the proper colored badge. Non members of the Arizona Chapter are not allowed to speak to a motion or allowed to vote.
9. Membership status will be verified onsite through the Arizona Chapter database or through the APTA (national) membership directory.
